Information Statement

Name of Public Authority: Financial Assistance Review Board

Introduction:

The Financial Assistance Review Board has a legal duty under the Public Access to Information Act 2010 to maintain and update annually an Information Statement. This will facilitate easy access to information by the public and increase the accountability and transparency of the Board, which will endeavor to proactively publish as much information as possible.

The purpose of this Information Statement is to outline the information held by the Financial Assistance Review Board which will be readily available to the public under the PATI Act 2010. The Information Statement is divided into several different categories to help the public access the information that they are seeking:

Section H contains any other relevant information held by the Financial Assistance Review Board.

Section I explains where copies of the Information Statement may be obtained.

Section A: Structure, Organization and Legislation [s5(1)a]

The Financial Assistance Review Board is established and governed by the Financial Assistance Act 2001 and the Financial Assistance Regulations 2004 under the Ministry responsible for Labour.

The Board consists of five members, a chairman, a deputy chairman and three other members.

Section B: 1) Functions, powers, duties of the Authority [s5(1)b]

Functions of Board under the Financial Assistance Act 2001 [sections 16(1)]:

Generally the Board reviews and may make a further decision on an appeal that was concluded by the Director of the Department of Financial Assistance as follows:

Determination of Appeals:

- a. On an appeal under section 14 the Board may confirm, vary reverse the decision which is subject of the appeal.
- b. The Board may attach special conditions to an award or penalty;
- c. The Board may revoke an award and require repayment of awards subject to section 13 of the Act

Section B: 2) Obligations under PATI Act [s5(1)b]

- To provide an information statement for the public and promulgate it [s5],
- To provide **other information** to the public so that the public needs only to have minimum resort to the use of the Act to obtain information [s6]. This includes:
 - General information, e.g. activities of the Authority
 - Log of all information requests and their outcome
 - Quarterly expenditure (upon request) [s6(5)]
 - Contracts valued at \$50,000 or more.
- To respond to information requests in a timely manner [s12-16]

- To track information requests, and provide this data to the Information Commissioner
- To respond to requests from the Information Commissioner [s9]
- To **amend personal information** held by the Authority that it is wrong or misleading following a written request by the person to whom the information relates [s19]
- To conduct an **internal review**, if formally requested [part 5]
- To give evidence for **review by the Information Commissioner** [part 6, 47(4)], or for **judicial review** [s49], if required
- To provide an **annual written report** to the Information Commissioner of the status of information requests [s58 (3)].
- To do anything else as required under the PATI Act and subsequent Regulations [s59, 60], including:
 - Fees for requests for information
 - Management and maintenance of records
 - Procedures for administering the Act
- To train staff and make arrangements so as to facilitate compliance with the Act [s61]
- To designate one of its officers to be the person to whom requests are directed [s62]

Section C: Services and Programmes [s5(1)c]

Services

1. The Board reviews and provides the final decisions of appeals against the decisions of the Director of the Department of Financial Assistance.

Programmes. Not applicable - the Board has no programmes.

Records are held by the Financial Assistance Review Board.
